

Enrollment Confirmation 2019

Thank you for registering for AZ FCA's SUMMER CAMP!

We look forward to spending four days with your athlete in northern Arizona this summer. Our camps offer challenging sports competition and instruction while providing the opportunity to explore and grow in Christian faith through challenging messages and discussion groups. Your athlete will form friendships with other athletes while learning from carefully selected coaches, collegiate and professional athletes, and FCA's professionally trained full-time staff.

What to Bring

- You must bring sheets, blanket (or sleeping bag), pillow, towel, washcloth, soap, sun block, and toiletries.
- Modest attire is required at all times during camp. The climate can be warm during the day and cool at night. Keep your clothing and equipment simple.
- Bring shoes and equipment you will need for the work-out and clinic sessions. Football, Baseball, Soccer, and Softball campers should bring both cleats and tennis shoes.
- Game equipment, such as balls, will be provided. It's a good idea to bring your own water bottle and small fan for your room. A notebook and a pen will also be needed.
- Hydrate before camp! Northern Arizona University sits at an elevation of 6900 feet. Please keep the high altitude in mind and drink plenty of water before and during camp.

What NOT to bring:

- Expensive items like jewelry, radios, iPad. FCA is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Any vaping products, all forms of tobacco, illegal substances and alcohol. E-Cigarettes are prohibited on campus by the tobacco-free policy. **ANYONE CAUGHT IN POSSESSION WILL BE SENT HOME IMMEDIATELY AT PARENT'S EXPENSE.**

Medication

- If your child will take medication to camp, that information was entered when you registered online. If changes have occurred, fill out a medication administration form and bring it to camp check in.
- It is the camper's responsibility to go to the camp health office to get their medication. Medication is administered 10 minutes before through 10 minutes after each meal (in lobby as you enter the dining hall), as well as after the evening session in the auditorium lobby.
- Daily and as needed medications must be turned in at check in Saturday morning at check in (in Flagstaff or at busses).
- **EMERGENCY medications must be carried on the camper at all times during camp**, the medication administration form is still required.
- The medication administration form is available on camp website: azfca.org, camp page.
- Any medication not picked up on Tuesday (at buses or NAU) will be disposed of.
- Acetaminophen and ibuprophen will be available in the camp health office for those who gave permission to administer when you registered.

Insurance

FCA will only provide secondary insurance coverage during camp. In case of injury or illness the camper will need to provide proof of insurance coverage at the time of treatment. Campers not covered by family insurance will be cared for.

Location & Dining

Northern Arizona University is located 150 miles north of Phoenix. 306 E. Pine Knoll Drive, Flagstaff, Arizona 86011.

We will eat our meals in the NAU cafeteria. "Simple servings" is a designated section of their cafeteria that provides a variety of offerings that are void of the following food allergens: shellfish, milk, wheat, gluten, soy, eggs, peanuts and tree nuts.

FCA Store

Enrollment fees cover all essentials, but you will no doubt want "spending money" for incidentals and extras, such as FCA apparel available for sale in the FCA Store. This is your one time of the year to purchase FCA merchandise at a camp discounted price and without shipping costs applied! Don't miss this great opportunity!

Flagstaff check in or pick up

Check in/ pick up for campers not traveling on buses from Phoenix or Tucson, will take place from 11am-12pm at Northern Arizona University. Boys will be checked in at their dorm, Sechrist Hall. Girls will be checked in at their dorm, Reilly Hall. There will be signs to follow. If you are picking your camper up in Flagstaff, please pick them up from their dorms at 1:30 on Tuesday. Medications for male/female campers will be picked up from Reilly dorms. Any medication not picked up will be disposed of.

1. Take exit 341 to McConnell Dr.
2. Turn right onto E McConnell Dr.
3. Turn left onto S Knoles Dr.
4. Turn right onto E Runke Dr.
5. Turn left toward Campus Heights St.
6. Turn right onto Campus Heights St.
7. Turn right at the 1st cross street onto University Dr. Reilly Hall will be on the right.

*Directions to Sechrist Hall (male check in/pick up)

1200 S. Beaver St., Sechrist Hall, Flagstaff 86011. Building 42 on the NAU map.

From 1-17 North to Sechrist Hall:

1. Take exit 341 to McConnell Dr.
2. Turn right onto E McConnell Dr.
3. Turn left onto S San Francisco St.
4. Turn left onto W University Dr.
5. Turn right toward Beaver Street Transit Way.
6. Continue onto Beaver Street Transit Way.

If you signed up for bus transportation FROM PHOENIX or TUCSON to or from camp:

Busing is provided to/from camp for those who selected this option when registering for camp (no additional cost). Please make proper arrangements for pick-up (times and locations below). Make sure your camper knows where they are being picked up from Tuesday (in Flagstaff, or taking the bus back to Phoenix/Tucson) and who is picking them up. **Email any request for change in transportation to your camp registrar by June 26th** and we'll let you know if we can accommodate.

• **Phoenix Buses**

Check in begins Saturday, June 29th at 7:30 am at Christ's Church of the Valley, Peoria campus, 7007 W Happy Valley Rd, Peoria, AZ 85383-3223, south parking lot off of Hatfield Road. Buses will depart from Phoenix at 8:15 am. The buses will return to CCV Peoria on Tuesday, July 2nd at approximately 4:30 PM.

• **Tucson Buses**

Check in begins Saturday, June 29th at 6:00 am at the Walmart on Cortaro and I-10 (west of the freeway). Buses will depart from Tucson at 7:00 am. The buses will return to Walmart on Tuesday, July 2nd at approximately 6:00 PM.

Balance

- Your balance will be automatically charged on June 18th to the card used for initial deposit at registration. If you need to update card information before then, log into the registration system and make an update. Registrars (below) can assist.
- Balance must be paid in full on June 18th for camper to attend camp.
- No refunds for cancellations after 5pm on June 18th. Cancellations on or before June 17th will forfeit the \$60 deposit.
